The change in footfall for Weymouth BID over the last 52 weeks is 3.8% down on the previous year.

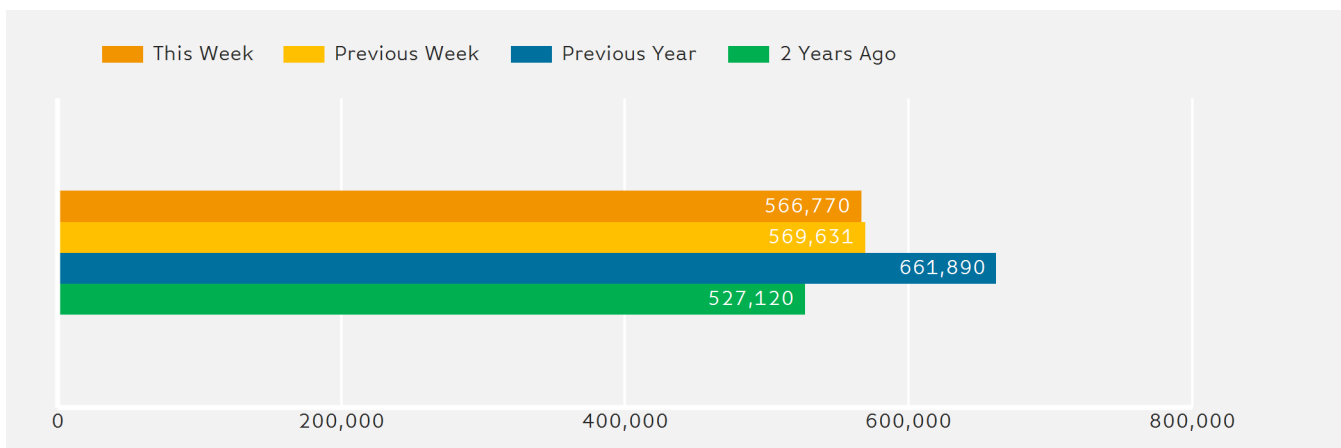
Footfall for the year to date is 8.4% down on the previous year.

The number of visitors counted for week commencing 16 April 2018 was 566,770.

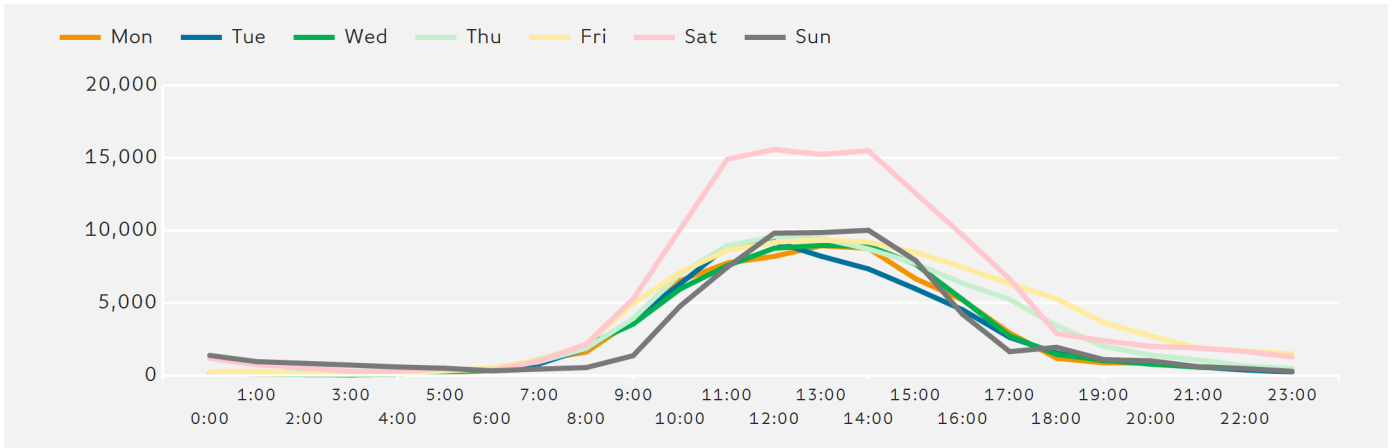
The busiest day in week commencing 16 April 2018 was Saturday with 124,492 visitors.

### Footfall by Week



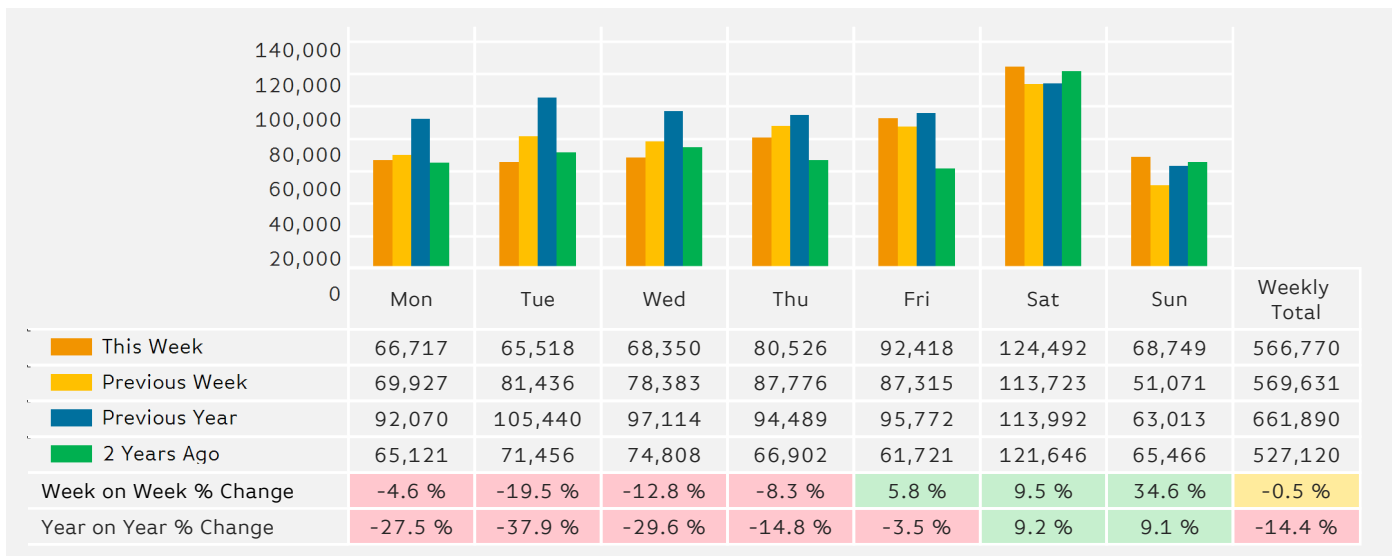
### Footfall by Hour



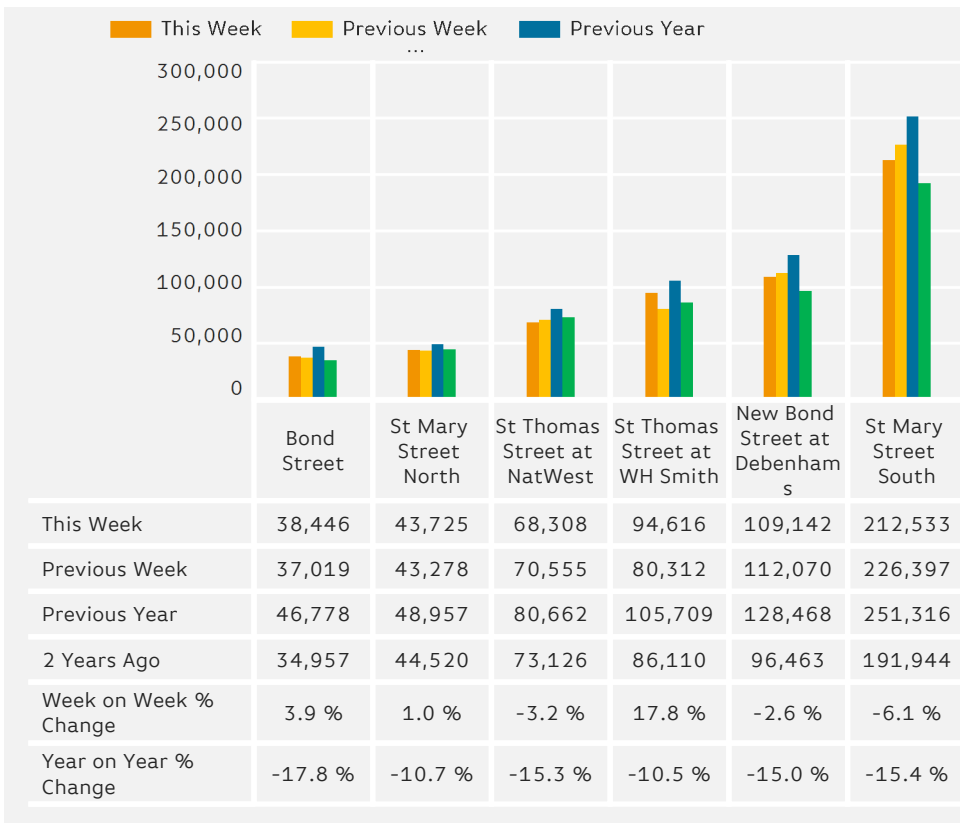

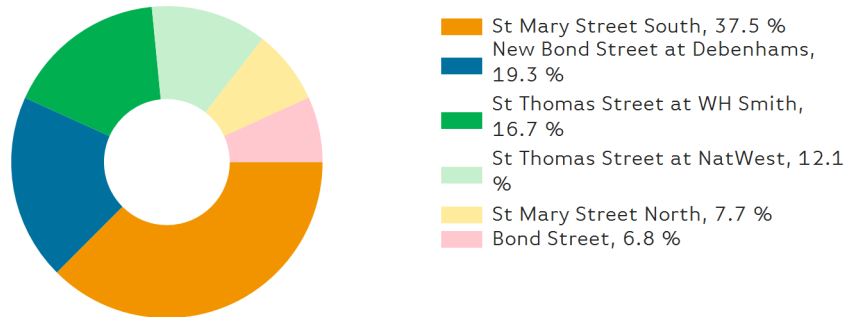

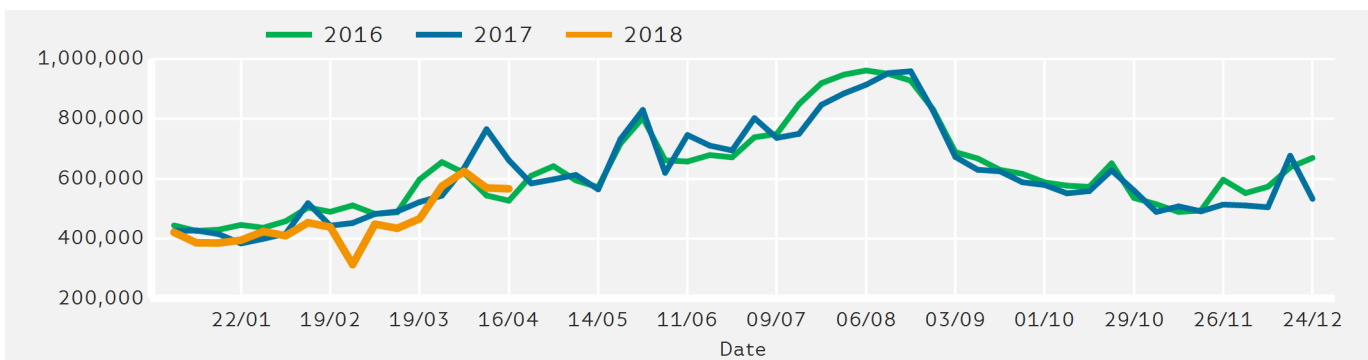
