Q7 Age Group

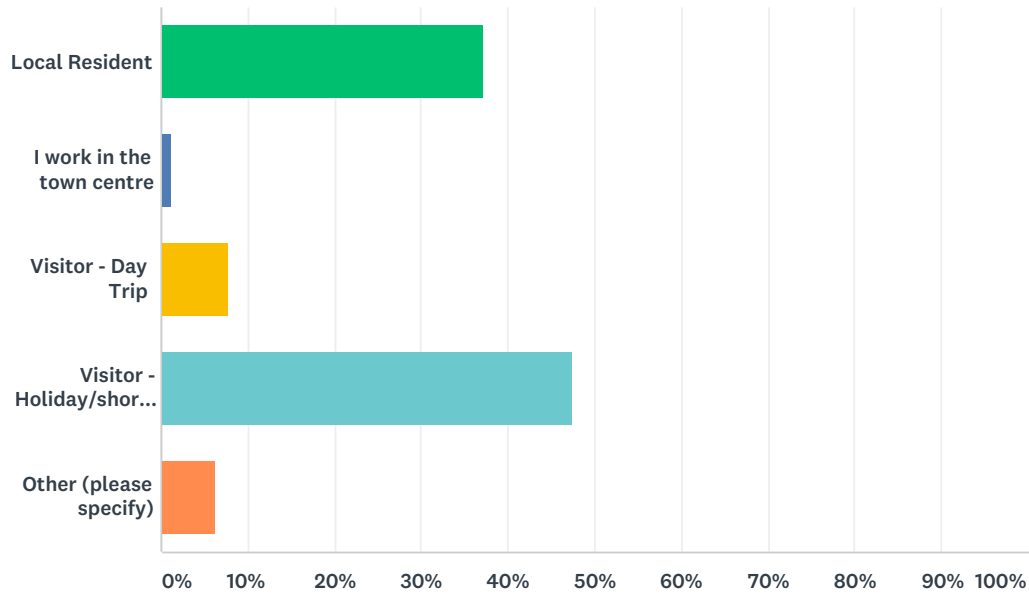

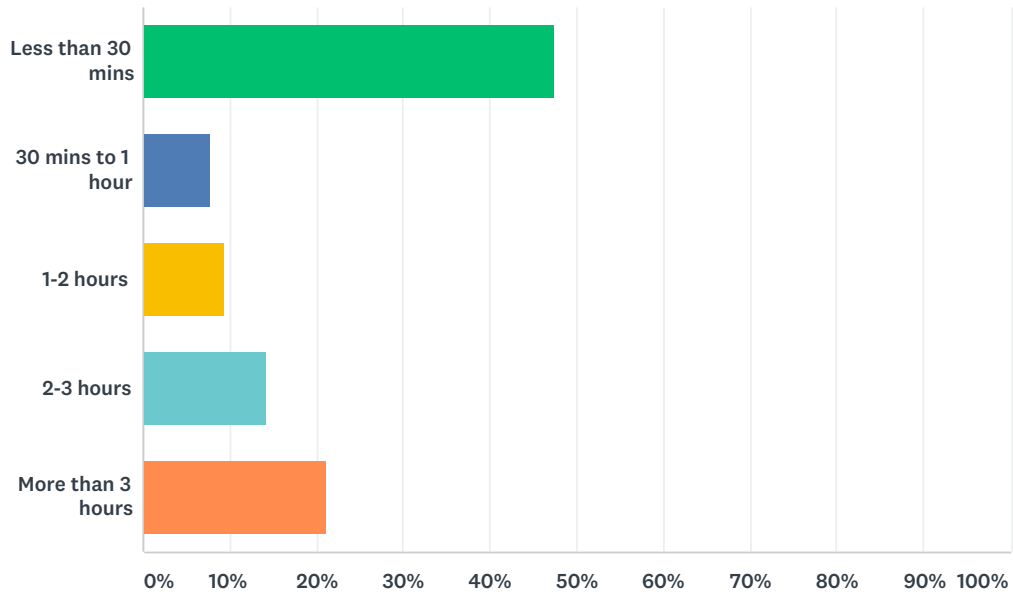

Q9 How far was your journey into Weymouth town centre?

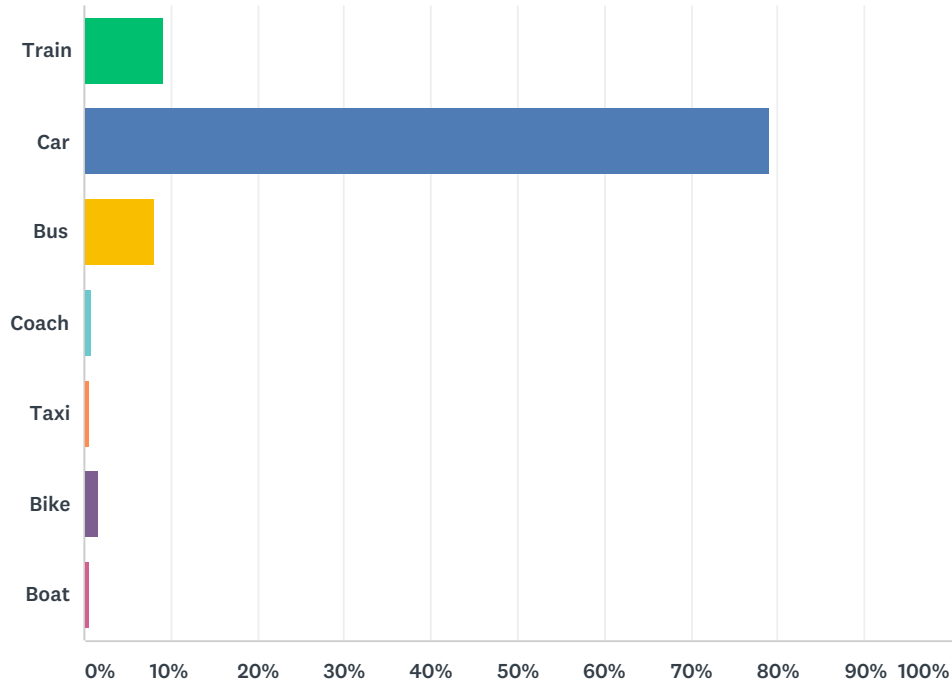
